

## Installation Guide

### Set up the switch

Prepare the installation site so that mounting requirements are met.

Note: For more information about the POST process, the LED indicators, and connection guide, which you can download by visiting <https://www.netgear.com/support/product>

1. Install the switch using one of the following methods:
  - **On a flat surface.** Attach one of the four screws to the back of the switch on each of the four corners.
  - **In a rack.** Use the rack-mount kit.

2. Apply AC power.

The Power LED lights solid yellow when the switch is powered on. After the POST completion test (POST). After the POST completion test (POST), the Power LED will light in one of the following colors:

- **Solid green.** The switch is functioning normally.
- **Solid yellow.** The POST failed.

If the Power LED does not light at all, the switch is not plugged in correctly and that the power source is not working.

3. Connect devices to the switch.
